11. The actual number of chapter tests is subject to change, but there will be no more than five. If you are unable to take an exam you must notify the instructor *before* the test was to be taken. One make-up exam for a missed exam *may possibly* be given, but at the discretion of the instructor. If an exam is missed and not made-up then the possible final exam grade will increase from 200 points to 300 points.

FINAL EXAM: A **required**, comprehensive final exam will be given **Friday, December 12, from 8:15 am to 10:15 pm.** The final exam will be given in our regular classroom.
